Lower Abdomen (Ultrasonography)

Both Kidneys are normal in size. Right kidney measures ~8.5x3.4cm. Left kidney measures ~9.3x4.4cm. Bilateral cortical echogenicity are normal with normal corticomedullary differentiation. Bilateral parenchymal thickness is normal. No mass lesion, calculus or hydronephrosis is seen.

Urinary Bladder is adequately distended with normal. No mass lesion, calculus or diverticulum is noted in the urinary bladder. Urinary bladder wall thickness is normal.

Uterus is anteverted with normal in size (8.5x5.1cm) and echotexture. Endometrial thickness is within normal limit (8.0mm).

Cervix- Normal in size (26mm) & echotexture.

Both ovaries appear normal.

Right adnexa shows an ill defined heterogeneous lesion measuring ~8.7x5.2cm having vascularity noted within. The lesion shows G Sac having yolk sac without definite fetal pole. Moderate fluid collection in peritoneal cavity and pelvic cavity with internal echoes within (Hemoperitoneum).

Miscellaneous- No significant adenopathy seen.
No pleural effusion seen.

Impression:

Right adnexa shows an ill defined heterogeneous lesion having vascularity noted within. The lesion shows G Sac having yolk sac without definite fetal pole. Moderate fluid collection in peritoneal cavity and pelvic cavity with internal echoes within (Hemoperitoneum) – Finding are suggestive of right tubal ruptured ectopic pregnancy.
