WHOLE ABDOMINAL SONOGRAPHY

- LIVER** : Large lobulated hypoechoic mass lesion of size 9.4 x 9.3 x 8.6 cm is noted in right lobe of liver suggestive of Neoplastic mass (? Hepatocellular carcinoma). IHBR's & CBD Are Normal in Appearance.
- PORTAL VEIN** : Portal Vein Is Normal In Size, Hepatopetal Flow.
- IVC & HV** : Sizes Normal, Respiratory Variations Normal.
- GALL BLADDER** : Lumen Is Well Distended & Echofree. No Calculus Or Sludge Is Seen.
- SPLEEN** : Normal In Size, Shape & Echotexture. No Focal Lesion Seen. Splenic Vein - Normal.
- RETROPERITONEUM:** Pancreas Normal In Size And Echotexture. No Retroperitoneal / Paraaortic Lymphadenopathy. Aorta Normal.
- RIGHT KIDNEY** : Right Kidney Appear Normal In Size, Shape & Echotexture. Right kidney size - 8.5 x 3.5 cms. Cortical Thickness & Corticomedullary Differentiation Normal. No calculus and No Hydronephrosis.
- LEFT KIDNEY** : Left Kidney Appear Normal In Size, Shape & Echotexture. Left kidney size - 8.6 x 3.9 cms. Cortical Thickness & Corticomedullary Differentiation Normal. No calculus and No Hydronephrosis.
- PROSTATE** : Prostate is enlarged in size Measuring- 5.3 x 5.0 x 4.8 cm, vol- 68.0 cc. No Median Lobe Bulge. Echotexture Normal.
- URINARY BLADDER:** Shows Normal Uniform Wall Thickness with Smooth Inner Margin.

OTHER FINDINGS:

- Few enlarged periportal lymphnodes 2.4 x 1.0 cm are seen.

IMPRESSION:

- Large lobulated hypoechoic mass lesion is noted in right lobe of liver suggestive of Neoplastic mass (? Hepatocellular carcinoma)
- Grade- III prostatomegaly.
- Few enlarged periportal lymphnodes are seen.

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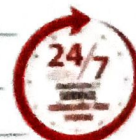

CT SCAN - HEAD (PLAIN STUDY)

IMAGING PROTOCOL: High resolution axial scans of 05 mm thickness from the base & thereafter of 10 mm thickness are recorded.

INFRATENTORIAL FOSSA:

- Cerebellum, pons and brain stem structures are normal.
- 4th ventricle is in mid line and CP angle is clear.
- No focal posterior cranial fossa lesion seen.

SUPRATENTORIAL FOSSA:

- Diffuse confluent hypodensity noted in periventricular white matter of bilateral parieto occipital lobe suggestive of mild microvascular ischemic changes.
- CSF spaces of the brain: ventricles, sulci and cisterns are normal.
- Rest of the brain parenchyma shows normal grey and white matter zones.
- No extra axial lesion / collection seen.
- 3rd ventricle lies in mid line and no mid line shift seen.
- The cranial vault and sella and air sinuses visualized are normal. Scalp tissue also appears normal.

OPINION: NCCT study reveals:

- Diffuse confluent hypodensity noted in periventricular white matter of bilateral parieto occipital lobe suggestive of mild microvascular ischemic changes.

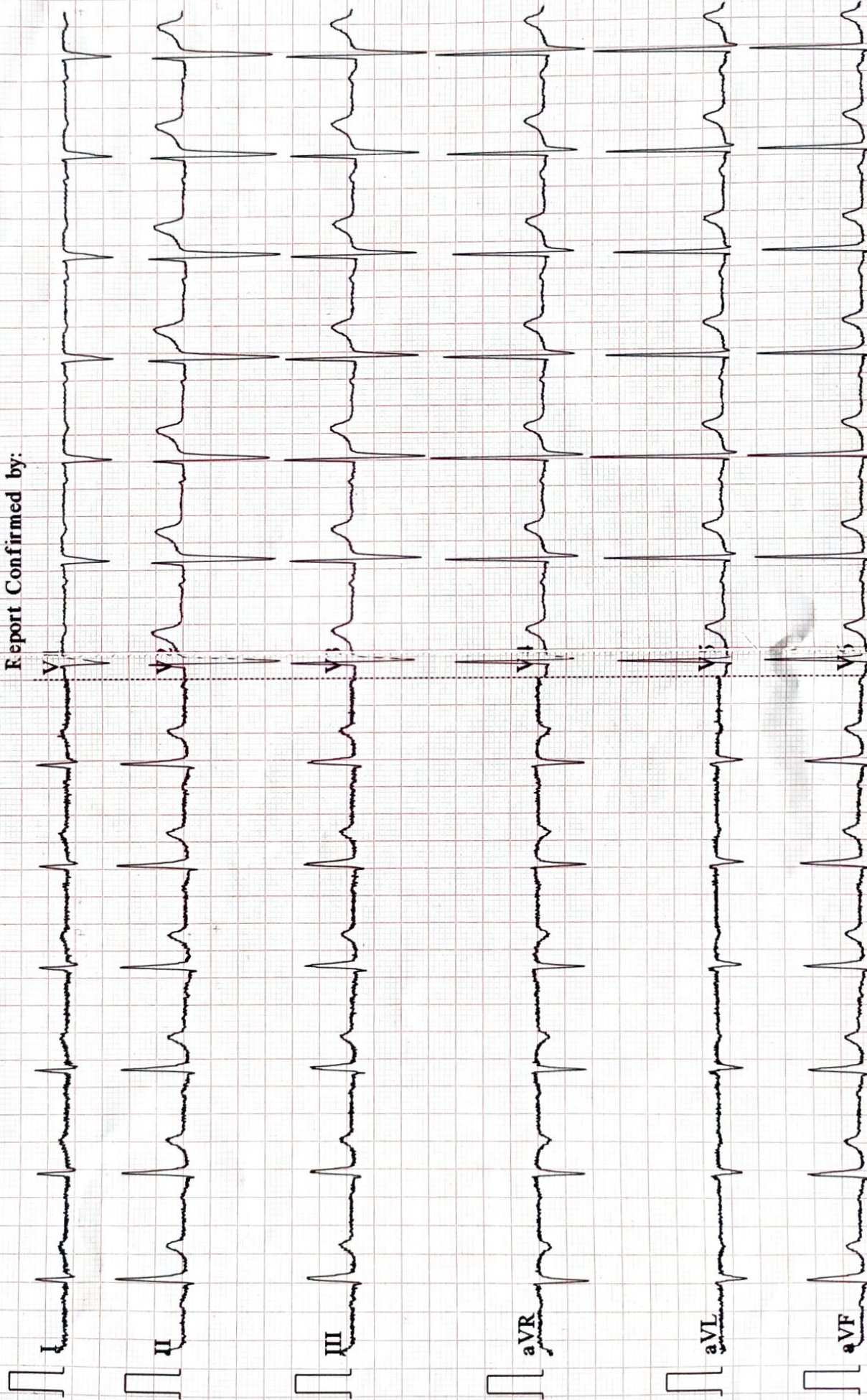
