ULTRASONOGRAPHY OF ABDOMEN & PELVIS.

Liver appears normal in size, shape and echotexture. No e/o any focal or diffuse lesion noted. The portal and biliary radicals appear normal.

Gall bladder is well distended and appears sonolucent. No e/o gall bladder wall thickening or calculus noted. **CBD** appears normal.

Pancreas is obscured.

Spleen is normal in size measures (8.5 cm) and echopattern with no focal or diffuse lesion noted.

Right Kidney measures: 9.7 x 4.3 cm, is normal in size, shape, position and cortical echogenicity. The cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. No focal lesion. No obvious calculus is seen.

Left Kidney measures: 9.3 x 5.0 cm is normal in size, shape, position and cortical echogenicity. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. No focal lesion. No obvious calculus is seen.

Bilateral kidney shows mild hydronephrosis (left > right) likely secondary to chronic cystitis.

Urinary bladder is well distended with thickened irregular bladder wall measuring 6 mm and trabaculations within. No calculus or focal lesion seen.

Prostate: Grossly appears enlarged in size Prostate measures: - 2.9 x 4.4 x 4.2 cm. Prostate volume: - 30 cc.


Other: Visualized bowel loops are gaseously distended.
No free fluid in abdomen and pelvis.
No lymphadenopathy noted.

IMPRESSION-

- *f/s/o chronic changes of cystitis with resultant bilateral hydronephrosis (left > right)*
- *Mild prostatomegaly.*

Adv: CT urography for further evaluation.
