CECT CHEST & ABDOMEN WITH CECT UROGRAPHY

The study reveals:

Both lung fields show normal vascular markings. No focal or diffuse abnormality is seen.

The cardiac chambers are normal in size and outline.

The ascending and descending aorta and the aortic arch appear normal in course and caliber. Pulmonary trunk and arteries are normal in outline.

Trachea is normal in outline, course and caliber. No midline shift is noted.

No significant mediastinal lymphadenopathy is seen.

There is no evidence of any pleural effusion or thickening.

Oesophagus is normal in outline. No evidence of any dilatation or stricture is seen.

Liver is normal in size, outline, shape and attenuation and show normal enhancement on post contrast images. No evidence of focal lesion seen. Intrahepatic biliary radicals and hepatic venous channels are normal.

Portal vein is normal in caliber, course and enhancement.

Gall bladder is normal in outline and position. Gall bladder wall is uniform and normal in thickness. Common bile duct is not dilated.

Pancreas is normal in size, outline and texture.

Spleen is normal in size, outline, position and attenuation.

Both adrenal glands are unremarkable.

Right kidney is normal in outline size, position and attenuation. No hydronephrosis is seen. No calculus/ lesion is seen on right side. Perirenal spaces and fascial planes are normal. Ureter is normal in course and caliber on right side.

An approx. 6.5 x 6.4 cm heterogeneously enhancing mass lesion is noted involving the left kidney with extension into the left renal pelvis with extension into the proximal left ureter, the lesion is encasing the left renal vein, left renal artery, peripherally cortical enhancement is noted with a speck of calcification.

Retroperitoneum is normal. No evidence of significant lymphadenopathy seen.

No free fluid is seen in abdomen.

Urinary bladder is normal in outline and position. Urinary bladder wall is uniform.


Uterus is normal in size, shape and texture. Both adnexa are normal.

Visualised bowel loops are unremarkable.

Impression: - CECT chest and abdomen reveals:

An approx. 6.5 x 6.4 cm heterogenously enhancing mass lesion is noted involving the left kidney with extension into the left renal pelvis with extension into the proximal left ureter, the lesion is encasing the left renal vein, left renal artery, peripherally cortical enhancement is noted with a speck of calcification -- ? TCC.

Suggested: Clinical and Histopathological correlation.
