The graph shows a risk curve that starts at 1:1000 at age 13 and rises to 1:10 at age 41. A horizontal line at 1:1000 represents the cut-off. The area above the cut-off is red, the area below the cut-off but above the age risk curve is yellow, and the area below the age risk curve is green. A black vertical bar at age 41 indicates the patient's risk is below the cut-off.			The calculated risk for Trisomy 21 (with nuchal translucency) is below the cut off, which indicates a low risk. After the result of the Trisomy 21 test (with NT) it is expected that among 4179 women with the same data, there is one woman with a trisomy 21 pregnancy and 4178 women with not affected pregnancies. The calculated risk by PRISCA depends on the accuracy of the information provided by the referring physician. Please note that risk calculations are statistical approaches and have no diagnostic value! The patient combined risk presumes the NT measurement was done according to accepted guidelines (Prenat Diagn 18: 511-523 (1998)). The laboratory can not be hold responsible for their impact on the risk assessment ! Calculated risks have no diagnostic value!
