Ultrasonography of gravid uterus (Early anomaly/NT scan)

- ❖ Single live intrauterine fetus with changing lie & unstable presentation is seen at the time of examination.
- ❖ CRL measures 6.41 cm corresponds to 12 weeks 6 days.
- ❖ BPD measures 2.01 cm, corresponds to 13 weeks 1 day.
- ❖ Foetal cardiac activity is noted. Foetal heart rate 146 b/min.
- ❖ Nuchal translucency- 1.6 mm.
- ❖ Intra-cranial translucency- 1.9 mm.
- ❖ Nasal bone (3.0 mm), Tricuspid flow: within normal limits.
- ❖ Ductus venosus flow is normal.
- ❖ Placenta: Left lateral wall, upper and mid uterine segment. Grade-0 maturity.
- ❖ OS closed.
- ❖ Both ovaries appear normal in size and echotexture.
- ❖ Cervical length 4.1 cm.
- ❖ Urinary bladder shows normal uniform wall thickness with smooth inner margin.
- ❖ Right UTA
 - Pulsatility index - 1.9
- ❖ Left UTA
 - Pulsatility index - 2.1
 - Mean PI percentile - 2.1
 - Result - Normal
