NUCHAL TRANSLUCENCY SCAN (NT)

LMP - 20 Nov 2023, MA- 13 Wks 3 Days EDD- 26 Aug 2024

Real time ultrasound done with 3 to 5 MHz. convex probe reveals

A single well-defined gestational sac with single fetus.

CRL - 7.18 cm = 13 Wks 3 Days.

USG EDD - 26 Aug 2024

Normal fetal cardiac activity appreciated. FHR - 152 bpm. No tricuspid regurgitation seen.

Normal Nasal bone (2.7 mm) & Nuchal translucency seen. NT measures 1.66 mm.

Ductus venosus shows normal waveform.

Both upper and lower limbs are well visualized with normal ossification of cranial bones.

Choroid plexuses filling the lateral ventricles are seen with intact inter-hemispheric fissure and normal appearing stomach bubble.

Normal 'parallel' inflow and 'V shaped' outflow from fetal heart could be demonstrated.

Mean Uterine artery PI is 1.52 (at 46th percentile) - normal.

Amount of liquor is adequate.

Placenta is forming anteriorly.

The cervical canal is normal in length (3.19 cms). Internal os is closed.

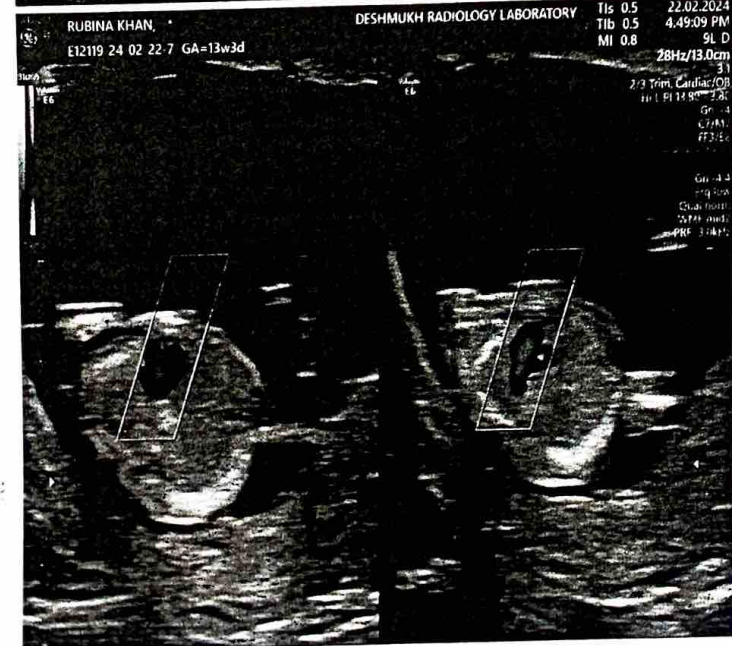
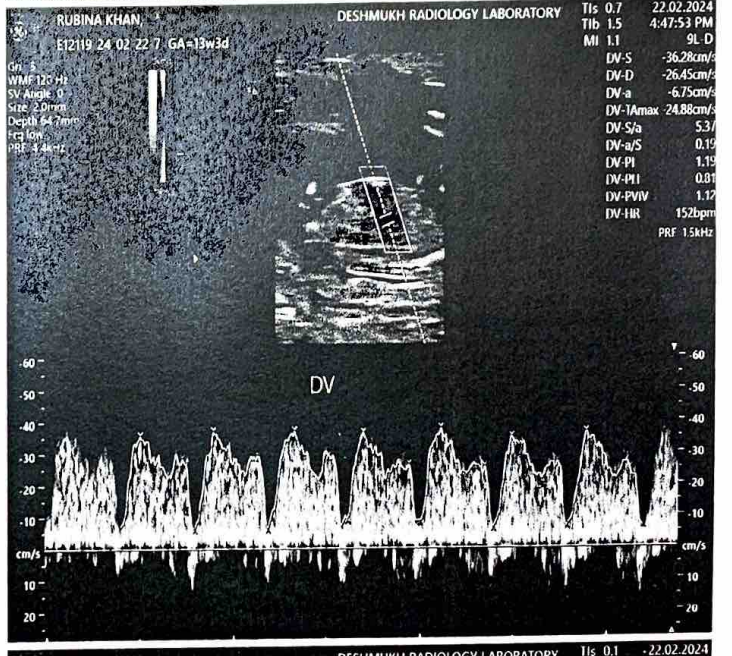
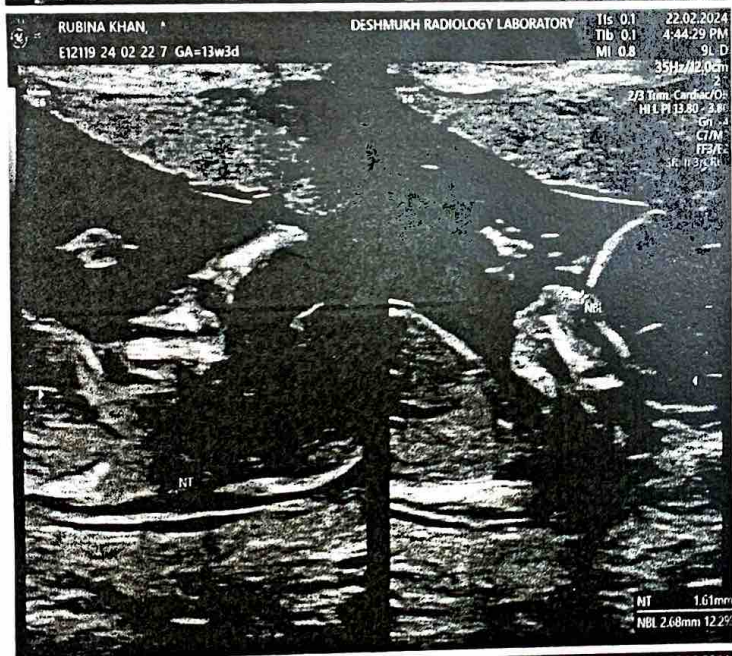
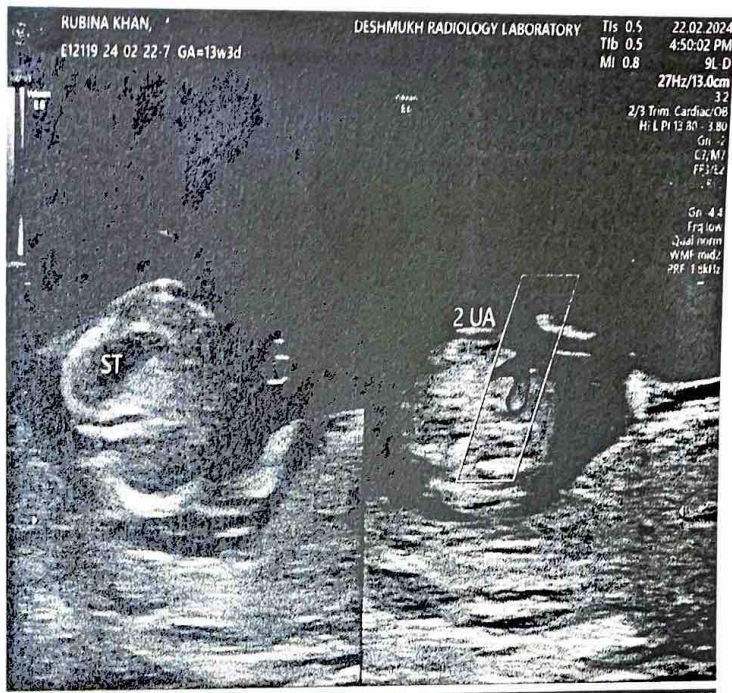
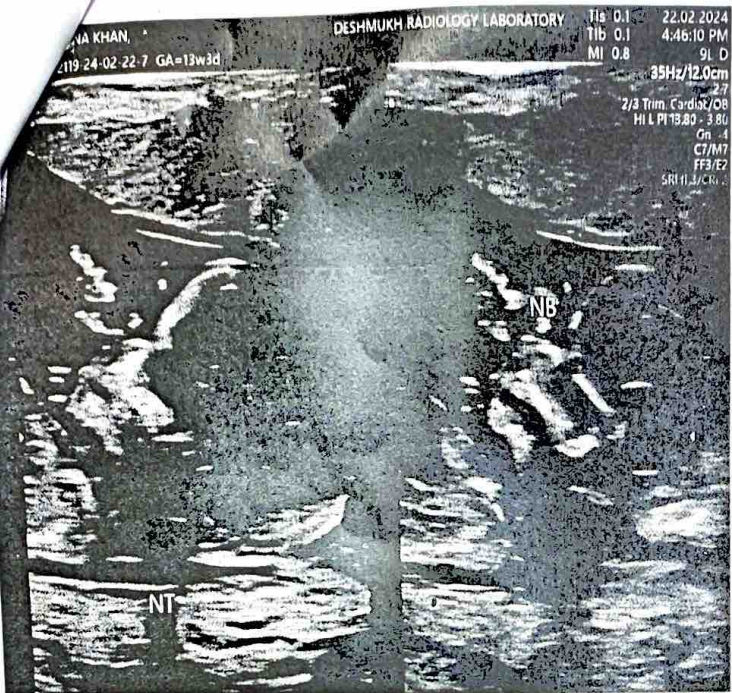
IMPRESSION: - Single live intrauterine pregnancy of 13 Wks 3 Days.

Preeclampsia risk from history only

< 37 weeks: 1 in 500

Preeclampsia risk from history plus MAP, UTPI

< 37 weeks: 1 in 1667 (low risk)

Recommendation

The risk of preeclampsia was assessed by a combination of maternal characteristics and medical history with measurements of blood pressure and blood flow to the uterus.

On the basis of this assessment the patient has been classified as being at low risk for developing PE before 37 weeks. Nevertheless, it is recommended that the risk is reassessed at 20 and 36 weeks.
