Screening of Body Parts:

HEAD:

Skull - Normal / dolicocephalic

Nuchal fold thickness 3.5 mm

Orbital diameter- 10 mm

Inter orbital distance- 11 mm

Palate, Lips & Nose appear normal



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Brain - Cerebellar diameter (TS) - 20 mm

Cisterna magna - 6.4 mm

Atria of lateral ventricle - 6.7 mm

All the above measurements are within Normal limits.

Fetal Spine : Appears normal. (Parallielism of anterior and posterior lamillae is well maintained)

Chest: Bilateral Lung appear normal in morphology and parenchymal echogenicity.
Diaphragm appears normal

Heart: 4 chambers views suggest normal sizes of all cardiac chambers

- Normal situs
- Normal outflow tracts

Abdomen: - Cord insertion - Normal

- 3 Vessel cord is noted

Stomach: Bubble well visualized, normal in position.

Normal distribution, diameter and echogenicity of bowel loops.

Kidney: Bilateral kidneys are normal in size and echogenicity.

No evidence of hydronephrosis

Urinary Bladder: appears normal.

Limbs: Humerus length: 31 mm
Tibial length: 29 mm
Foot length: 33 mm

Above screening suggest absence of any apparent congenital anomaly.

IMPRESSON:

Single live, Intrauterine gestation with EGA corresponding to 20 weeks + 1 day & no ELO gross congenital anomaly.
