After the result of the Trisomy 21 test (with NT) it is expected that among 6783 women with the same data, there is one woman with a trisomy 21 pregnancy and 6782 women with not affected pregnancies. The patient combined risk presumes the NT measurement was done according to accepted guidelines (Prenat Diagn 18: 511-523 (1998)).
