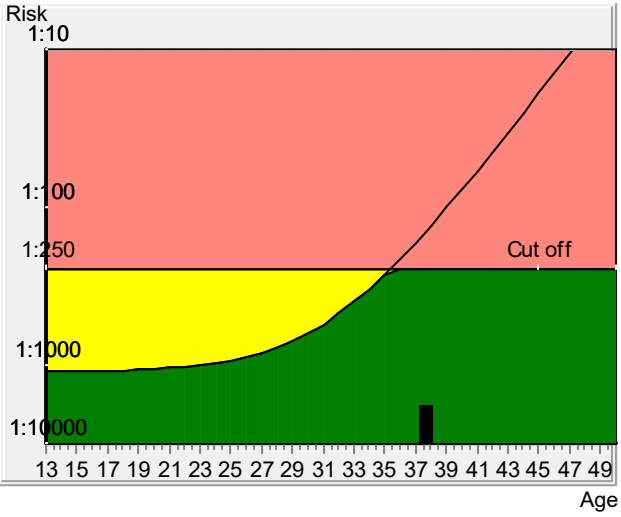

Age risk	1:143	The calculated risk for Trisomy 21 (with nuchal translucency) is below the cut off, which indicates a low risk.	
Biochemical T21 risk	1:1879	After the result of the Trisomy 21 test (with NT) it is expected that among 8333 women with the same data, there is one woman with a trisomy 21 pregnancy and 8332 women with not affected pregnancies.	
Combined trisomy 21 risk	1:8333	The calculated risk by PRISCA depends on the accuracy of the information provided by the referring physician. Please note that risk calculations are statistical approaches and have no diagnostic value!
