### OBSTETRIC ULTRASOUND

**LMP:** 20/01/2024

**Gestational ages by LMP:** 13 weeks and 0 days

Single live foetus in variable presentation and longitudinal lie at the time of scan.

**CRL measures** 3.1 cm corresponding to 10 weeks and 0 days

**Foetal cardiac activity:** is regular. Foetal heart rate is 172 beats/min. Foetal body and limb movements are normal.

**Umbilical cord:** is normal.

**Nuchal Translucency:** is normal in thickness and measured 1.4 mm.

**Nasal bone:** is not clearly visualized due to small fetal size.

**Internal os:** is closed. Cervix is 3 cm in length. Endocervical canal appears normal.


No gross fetal anomaly is seen.

**Impression:** Intrauterine single live fetus of 10 weeks and 0 days duration with variable presentation. NT appears normal.

Advice: Rescan after 3 weeks.
