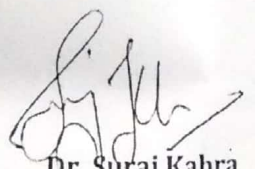
- ❖ Single intrauterine gestational sac with single live fetus with heart activity seen at the time of examination with gestational age of 12 weeks 2 days.
- ❖ Expected date of delivery by ultrasound: 23.11.024 +/- 10 days.
- ❖ Uterine artery screen negative for PIH.
- ❖ Measured nuchal translucency (1.5 mm) is 48th percentile for present CRL.
- ❖ Subchorionic collection.
- ❖ Placenta: Anterior wall, heterogeneous with multiple venous lakes within, mid and lower uterine segment extending upto the internal OS.

Suggest:- Follow up anomaly scan at 19-21 weeks. Correlation with biochemical markers.

ULTRASONOGRAPHY OF GRAVID UTERUS (NT SCAN)

- ❖ Single live intrauterine fetus with changing lie & unstable presentation is seen at the time of examination.
- ❖ CRL measures 5.59 cm corresponds to 12 weeks 1 day.
- ❖ BPD measures 1.60 cm corresponds to 12 weeks 2 days.
- ❖ Foetal cardiac activity is noted. Foetal heart rate 162 b/min.
- ❖ Nuchal translucency- 1.5 mm.
- ❖ Intra-cranial translucency- 2.2 mm.
- ❖ Nasal bone (1.7 mm), Tricuspid flow: within normal limits.
- ❖ Ductus venosus flow is normal.
- ❖ Placenta: Anterior wall, heterogeneous with multiple venous lakes within, mid and lower uterine segment extending upto the internal OS. Grade-0 maturity.
- ❖ Subchorionic collection is seen measuring 1.9 x 1.4 cm.
- ❖ OS closed.
- ❖ Both ovaries appear normal in size and echotexture.
- ❖ Cervical length 3.9 cm.
- ❖ Urinary bladder shows normal uniform wall thickness with smooth inner margin.
- ❖ Right UTA
 - Pulsatility index - 1.6
- ❖ Left UTA
 - Pulsatility index - 1.7
 - Mean PI percentile - 1.65
 - Result - Normal
