**DEPARTMENT OF RADIODIAGNOSIS AND IMAGING
SONOMAMMOGRAPHY OF BOTH BREASTS**

Clinical history : Check up.

Technique:

Ultrasound scan of breasts was performed with 7.5 MHz linear array transducer.

Findings:

Right breast :

Irregular ill defined mixed echoic area noted along the ductal confluence and mammary ducts in superolateral quadrant and subareolar region measuring 49 x15 x 41 mm noted in the pre mammary and subcutaneous plane of right breast communicating with mammary ducts. Very minimal collection is noted adjacent the ducts

No significant intramammary abscess is noted

Two small fibroadenomas measuring 18.5 x 10.1 mm and 8.3 x4.9 mm noted in the mammary space of right breast 10 'o clock position.

Two small fibroadenomas measuring 5.9 x 3.0 mm and 6.3 x 2 mm noted in the mammary space of right breast 2 ' o clock position.

Left Breast :

Small fibroadenoma measuring 13 x 5.5 mm noted in the mammary space of left breast at 2 'o clock position.

Small fibroadenoma 10 x5 mm noted in the mammary space of left breast at 2-3 'o clock position.

Small fibroadenoma 6.4 x 3.5 mm noted in the mammary space of left breast at 10 'o clock position.

Two small fibroadenomas measuring 7 x 3.5 mm and 7 x 4.7 mm noted in the mammary space of left breast 8-9 'o clock position.

Both breasts reveal predominantly fibroglandular parenchymal pattern with scanty fatty components.

No discrete focal mass/ collection / inflammatory changes noted.

Pre mammary, mammary and retromammary spaces are normal.

Both nipples, skin and subcutaneous tissues appear normal.

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Both axillary regions appear normal. No significant lymphadenopathy.

Visualized pectoralis muscles appear normal.

Few mildly enlarged right axillary lymph nodes noted with preserved benign morphology ,largest measuring 15 x 15mm. No necrosis / matting / lymphadenitis.

IMPRESSION:

- **F/s/o periductal mastitis of right breast along the ductal confluence and mammary ducts in superolateral quadrant and subareolar region subareolar region with very minimal premammary abscess formation**
- **Multiple small benign lesions in both breasts - Likely fibroadenomas**
- **Suggested clinical correlation.**
