Placenta- Posterior wall, upper and mid uterine segment. Grade-II maturity.

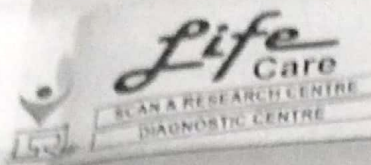
No obvious gross fetal anomaly is noticed in this examination.

The internal os and cervical canal are unremarkable.

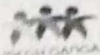
The cervix is normal (3.8 cm).
