- Single Live Intrauterine Pregnancy Breech Presentation Is Seen At The Time Of Examination Of 19 weeks + 2 days.

Advice: - Quadruple marker test correlation.

All measurement including foetal weight is subject to statistical variation. Fetal echo is not done.)

Note: - I Declare that while conducting USG, I have neither detected nor disclosed the sex of her fetus to any body in any manner.

Not all anomalies can be detected on sonography. Detection of anomalies is dependent on fetal position, gestational age. Maternal abdominal obesity and other technical parameters. Fetal limb anomalies not always detectable due to position. Follow up scanning and second opinion are always advisable. For detection of cardiac anomaly foetal echography is necessary. Ear anomalies cannot be detected.

USG OBSTETRICS WITH TARGETED IMAGING FOR FOETAL ANOMALIES (TIFFA)

Clinical Profile - NT scan report is suggestive of unossified nasal bone.

---Suboptimal scan due to patient excessive anterior abdominal wall fat.

Single live intrauterine fetus with Breech presentation is seen at the time of examination.

Liquor is adequate in amount.

The cardiac pulsations and fetal movements are well seen.

The fetal heart rate is = 153 b/minute.

The approximate gestational age is as follows:

Biparietal diameter	= 4.64 cm corresponds to 20.0 weeks.
Head circumference	= 16.76 cm corresponds to 19.3 weeks.
Abdominal circumference	= 13.86 cm corresponds to 19.2 weeks.
Femur length	= 2.93 cm corresponds to 19.0 weeks.
TIB	= 2.58 cm corresponds to 19.1 weeks.
FIB	= 2.37 cm corresponds to 18.2 weeks.
HL	= 2.94 cm corresponds to 19.4 weeks.
RAD	= 2.56 cm corresponds to 19.4 weeks.
Ulnar	= 2.73 cm corresponds to 20.0 weeks.
Cereb	= 1.96 cm corresponds to 19.0 weeks.

Placenta- Anterior wall, Grade-II maturity.

No obvious gross fetal anomaly is noticed in this examination.

The internal os and cervical canal are unremarkable.

The cervix is normal (3.8 cm).
