WHOLE ABDOMINAL SONOGRAPHY (TAS)

- LIVER** : Normal in size, shape & echotexture.
No focal lesion seen. IHBR'S & CBD are normal in appearance.
- PORTAL VEIN** : Normal in size, Hepatopetal flow.
- IVC & HV** : Sizes normal, respiratory variations normal.
- GALL BLADDER** : Lumen is well distended & echofree. No calculus or sludge is seen.
- SPLEEN** : Normal in size, shape & echotexture. No focal lesion seen.
Splenic vein is normal.
- RETROPERITONEUM** : Multiple lymph nodes in paraaortic region, largest of size 3.7 x 2.1 cm
-Need CECT abdomen for further evaluation.
- PANCREAS** : Normal in size and echotexture.
- ASCITES** : No free fluid seen in peritoneal cavity.
- RIGHT KIDNEY** : Normal in size, shape & echotexture. Cortical thickness &
corticomedullary differentiation normal. No calculus seen. No
hydronephrosis. Right kidney measures: 11.4x 5.3 cm.
- LEFT KIDNEY** : Small in size. Increased echotexture with relatively maintained
cortical thickness & corticomedullary differentiation. No calculus seen.
No hydronephrosis. Left kidney measures: 5.7 x 3.0 cm.
- URINARY BLADDER** : Partially distended. No obvious intraluminal calculus.
- UTERUS & BOTH OVARIES** : Post menopausal status.
- No obvious adnexal mass noted.
 - No free fluid seen in cul - de - sac.
 - No bowel wall thickening. Bowel loops are not dilated.
 - Both costo-phrenic angles are clear.

IMPRESSION:

- Multiple lymph nodes in paraaortic region, largest of size 3.7 x 2.1 cm - Need CECT abdomen for further evaluation.
- Left renal grade-II MRD.
- Left kidney small in size as compared to right.
