INDICATION(S)

ROUTINE OBSTETRIC SCAN.

Real Time B – mode ultrasonography of gravid uterus done.
Route: Trans abdominal.
Single intrauterine gestation.

Cervix Measures: 3.4 cm in Length.

**FETUS –
Survey**

- Placenta – Fundal Posterior, Lower edge of placenta is 2.0 cm away from OS, Low Lying.
- Liquor – Normal
- Presentation – Variable
- Lie - Variable
- Single Deepest Pocket = 3.7 cm and AFI = 13.1 cm.
- Umbilical Cord – Two Arteries And One Vein.
- Fetal Activity Present.
- Cardiac Activity Present
- Fetal Heart Rate - 150 bpm.

EDD BY USG – 06 Apr 2025

BPD : 3.5 cm	16 Weeks 6 Days
HC : 12.9 cm	16 Weeks 4 Days
AC : 9.9 cm	16 Weeks 0 Days
FL : 1.9 cm	15 Weeks 4 Days

Foot Length: 20 mm TCD: 15 mm.

Fetal Anatomy:-

- Head Imaged
- Spine Imaged.
- Heart and Face – Detail assessment not done.
- Stomach appeared normal. Both kidneys and bladder appeared normal.
- All long bones Imaged.
- Estimated fetal weight according to BPD,HC,AC,FL : 138 +/- 20 gms.

Impression:

- Single Live gestation corresponding to gestational age of 16 Weeks 2 Days.
- Placenta – Fundal Posterior, Lower edge of placenta is 2.0 cm away from OS, Low Lying.
- Presentation – Variable
- Liquor – Normal
- Estimated fetal weight according to BPD,HC,AC,FL : 138 +/- 20 gms.

THIS IS NOT A ANOMALY SCAN.

Suggested repeat scan at 19-20 weeks to assess anomalies in details.

- All congenital anomalies/malformations are not be detected on USG. (RCNA, JAN. 1990, VOL. 28).
- Fetal survey is limited by fetal position, movements, quantity of amniotic fluid & thickness of maternal anterior abdominal wall.
- Some anomalies are evident at later stages of pregnancy, for which follow-up is suggested.
