ULTRASONOGRAPHY OF WHOLE ABDOMEN

LIVER - Liver is normal in size measuring 14.69 cm and shape. Echogenicity is diffusely increased all over liver parenchymal. No focal lesion is noted. Intra hepatic Biliary radicals appear to be normal.

CBD - Normal in caliber measuring - 0.55 cm. **PV** - Normal in caliber measuring - 1.05 cm.

GALL BLADDER - Normal in size. Multiple calculus is seen in GB lumen. Gall bladder wall is normal.

PANCREAS - Normal in size and homogeneous in echo-pattern. No focal lesion is seen in pancreas. MPD is not dilated.

RIGHT KIDNEY - Measure 7.91 cm (approx.), normal in size, shape and positions. Parenchymal echogenicity and thickness normal. Normal cortico-medullary ratio and differentiation is seen in right kidney. No calculus is seen.

LEFT KIDNEY - Measure 8.66 cm (approx.), normal in size, shape and positions. Parenchymal echogenicity and thickness normal. Normal cortico-medullary ratio and differentiation is seen in left kidney. No calculus is seen.

AORTA - Retro- peritoneum is normal. No peri-aortic lymphadenopathy is seen.

SPLEEN - Spleen is normal in size measuring 7.19 cm and homogeneous in echo-pattern. Splenic vessels are not engorged.

URETERS - Both ureters are not dilated.

URINARY BLADDER - Wall thickness and contour are normal. No calculi or SOL is seen in urinary bladder.

UTERUS - Uterus is normal in size measuring 8.11 cm x 5.59 cm x 4.32 cm with normal outline and echotexture. No focal myometrial SOL is seen. The endometrium is central and normal, the endometrium cavity is empty. Cervix measures normal. No focal cervical lesion is seen.

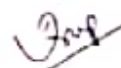
OVARIES & ADNEXAE - Rt. Ovary measures about 1.78 cm X 1.77 cm. Lt. Ovary measures about 1.80 cm X 1.93 cm. Both the adnexae are normal. No adnexal solid mass lesion is seen.

PELVIC PERITONEAL CAVITY - POD is clear.

RETROPERITONEUM - No enlarged lymph node is seen. The aorta and IVC are normal. Both iliac fossae are seen normal. No evidence of ascites and pleural effusion is seen.

IMPRESSIONS: Whole Abdomen Reveals:

- 1. Fatty Liver G-I.
- 2. Cholelithiasis.

NCCT Whole Abdomen:

Findings

Large cystic lesion of 222 x 248 mm seen at abdominopelvic cavity

Bilateral ovaries are not seen separately

Mild ascites seen

Intramuscular lipoma of 32 x 15 mm seen at right lateral abdominal wall

Liver shows normal size, shape and attenuation. No mass lesion or calcification in the hepatic parenchyma. The porta hepatis is normal. No IHBR or CBD dilatation.

Gall bladder reveals normal lumen and walls with normal size and shape. No mass lesion, calcification or CT detectable stone is seen within the lumen.

Pancreas appears normal in size and architecture. Pancreatic duct is not dilated.

Spleen is normal in size and architecture. No focal lesion.

Both kidneys reveal normal in size, shape, position and attenuation. No mass lesion, calcification or stone is seen in the renal parenchyma or collecting systems on both sides. No signs of obstructive uropathy are detected.

Both adrenals are visualised normally.

The IVC, aorta and portal vein are within normal position and calibre. No evidence of significant retroperitoneal lymphadenopathy or ascites.

The visible parts of the bowel loops show no obvious mass lesions or wall thickening. RIF appears normal.

Urinary bladder reveals normal lumen and walls. No vesical calculi, wall thickening or mass lesion.

Uterus appear atrophied
