USG OBSTETRICS WITH TARGETED IMAGING FOR FOETAL ANOMALIES (TIFEA)

-Suboptimal scan due to patient excessive anterior abdominal wall fat.
 Single live intrauterine fetus with breech presentation is seen at the time of examination.
 Liquor is adequate in amount.
 The cardiac pulsations and fetal movements are well seen.
 The fetal heart rate is = 147 b/minute.
 The approximate gestational age is as follows:

Biparietal diameter	= 4.55 cm corresponds to 19.5 weeks
Head circumference	= 17.18 cm corresponds to 19.5 weeks
Abdominal circumference	= 13.47 cm corresponds to 19.0 weeks
Femur length	= 3.21 cm corresponds to 20.0 weeks
TIB	= 2.81 cm corresponds to 20.1 weeks
FIB	= 2.85 cm corresponds to 20.1 weeks
HL	= 3.32 cm corresponds to 21.2 weeks
RAD	= 2.87 cm corresponds to 20.6 weeks
Ulnar	= 2.81 cm corresponds to 20.2 weeks
Cereb.	= 2.21 cm corresponds to 20.5 weeks

Placenta- Posterior wall, upper and mid uterine segment. Grade-II maturity.

No obvious gross fetal anomaly is noticed in this examination.

The internal os and cervical canal are unremarkable.

The cervix is normal (3.9 cm).

IMPRESSION:-

- Single live intrauterine pregnancy breech presentation at the time of examination of 20 weeks + 1 day.
- Intracardiac echogenic focus in the left ventricle

Advice: - Quadruple marker test correlation and follow up.

(All measurement including foetal weight is subject to statistical variation. Fetal echo is not done.)

Note: - I Declare that while conducting USG, I have neither detected nor disclosed the sex of her fetus to any body in any manner.

Not all anomalies can be detected on sonography. Detection of anomalies is dependent on fetal position, gestational age. Maternal abdominal obesity and other technical parameters. Fetal limb anomalies not always detectable due to position. Evolving skeletal dysplasias cannot be detected, needs serial growth monitoring Follow up scanning and second opinion are always advisable. For detection of cardiac anomaly foetal echography is necessary. Ear anomalies cannot be detected.
