The chart shows a risk curve that increases with age. At age 25, the risk is approximately 1:1000, which is below the cut-off line (approximately 1:250). The area below the cut-off is divided into yellow (below cut-off but above age risk) and green (below cut-off) regions.		The calculated risk for Trisomy 21 is below the cut off which represents a low risk. After the result of the Trisomy 21 test it is expected that among more than 10000 women with the same data, there is one woman with a trisomy 21 pregnancy. The calculated risk by PRISCA depends on the accuracy of the information provided by the referring physician. Please note that risk calculations are statistical approaches and have no diagnostic value!
