- Single live intrauterine foetus with changing presentation is seen at the time of examination.
- Liquor is adequate in amount.
- Cervical length- 3.3 cm.
- Foetal movements are identified and foetal heart is positive.

- Placenta: Posterior, Grade- 0.
- Nuchal Translucency (NT) measures: 0.9 mm, within normal limits.
- Nasal bone seen with nasal bone length of 2.4 mm.
- Ductus venosus reveals normal flow & spectral waveform.
- Increased left uterine artery PI (2.49) with early diastolic notching. Right uterine artery PI (1.53). Mean PI (2.01) is increased.
- No evidence of tricuspid regurgitation.

This scan is not level II scan; this is done only to assess fetal growth parameters fetal weight and fetal well being.

IMPRESSION

- Single live intrauterine foetus with changing presentation is seen at the time of examination, which corresponds, to Gestational age 13 Weeks 0 days. EDD- 18.08.2025 +/- 10 Days.
- Interval growth is normal.
- Increased left uterine artery PI (2.49) with early diastolic notching. Right uterine artery PI (1.53). Mean PI (2.01) is increased.

Advice- Anomaly scan at 18-22 weeks.
