DIAGNOSIS :

CHOLELITHIASIS WITH CALCULI

CLINICAL HISTORY :

The patient is a 46-year-old female with a known history of Type 2 Diabetes Mellitus (T2DM). She presented to the hospital with a chief complaint of intermittent abdominal pain for the past year, which had worsened over the last 7 days. Additionally, the patient reported experiencing shortness of breath (SOB) for the past day. Upon evaluation, ultrasound imaging revealed a Grade 1 fatty liver along with cholelithiasis and a calculous stone in the neck of the gallbladder. Given her symptoms and imaging findings, she was admitted for further management. The necessary preoperative investigations were carried out, and a physician consultation was done to assess her fitness for surgery, considering her underlying diabetes. After receiving medical clearance, the decision was made to proceed with laparoscopic cholecystectomy which was successfully carried out post procedure was uneventful, during the post operative days she was started on oral liquids and then to soft diet that she tolerated well without any complications ,postoperatively was managed with antibiotics ,analgesics and other symptomatic treatment .She was discharged in stable condition on postoperative Day 2, with instructions for follow-up care.
