Risk		Trisomy 21	
The chart shows a risk curve that starts at 1:10000 at 13 weeks and rises to 1:10 at 49 weeks. A horizontal line at 1:250 represents the cut-off. The area above the cut-off is red, the area between the cut-off and the risk curve is yellow, and the area below the risk curve is green. A vertical line at 27 weeks intersects the risk curve at a point between 1:1000 and 1:250.		The calculated risk for Trisomy 21 is below the cut off which represents a low risk. After the result of the Trisomy 21 test it is expected that among 989 women with the same data, there is one woman with a trisomy 21 pregnancy and 988 women with not affected pregnancies. The calculated risk by PRISCA depends on the accuracy of the information provided by the referring physician. Please note that risk calculations are statistical approaches and have no diagnostic value!
