Real time B mode obstetric scan reveals:

LMP: 04/01/2025

GA By LMP: 12 weeks 4 days EDD By LMP: 11/10/2025

GA By USG: 13 weeks 2 days

- Single live intrauterine fetus noted with changing lie.
- CRL: 7.15 cm corresponding to 13 weeks 2 days.
- Fetal cardiac activity present (FHR= 159 bpm).
- Nuchal Translucency measures : 1.6 mm ( Normal ).
- Nasal bone echo seen.
- Ductus venosus flow appears normal. PI - 0.94. 'a' wave appears normal.
- Urinary bladder visualized. Two umbilical arteries are seen.
- Placenta developing anteriorly.
- Cervical length measures 3.6 cm.
- Internal os is closed.
- No e/o subchorionic hemorrhage is noted.


IMPRESSION :
