Report of Histopathological Examination

Specimen: Gall bladder.

Gross Exam: Received gall bladder measuring 3x1.5cm . Serosa dull. Mucosa Ulcerated with focal thickening. Resected margin appears normal.

Microscopic Exam: Section shows thickened mucosa coming in papillary configuration with architectural complexity and atypia of glands. The glands are of variable size and shape coming deep in the muscle layer. The cells show nuclear hyperchromasia, focal loss of basal polarity of cells and cribriform pattern of glands.

IMPRESSION: Feature suggestive of Chronic cholecystitis with adenomyosis and glandular atypia.

Advised: Immunohistochemistry correlation to rule out neoplastic lesion.

Correlate with clinical & radiological findings.
