The chart shows a risk curve that increases with age. At age 21, the risk is below the cut-off. The area below the cut-off is green, the area between the cut-off and the age risk is yellow, and the area above the cut-off is red.		The calculated risk for Trisomy 21 is below the cut off which represents a low risk. After the result of the Trisomy 21 test it is expected that among more than 10000 women with the same data, there is one woman with a trisomy 21 pregnancy. The calculated risk by PRISCA depends on the accuracy of the information provided by the referring physician. Please note that risk calculations are statistical approaches and have no diagnostic value!
