Age risk	1:484		The calculated risk for Trisomy 21 (with nuchal translucency) is above the cut off, which indicates an increased risk.
Biochemical T21 risk	1:95		After the result of the Trisomy 21 test (with NT) it is expected that among 90 women with the same data, there is one woman with a trisomy 21 pregnancy and 89 women with not affected pregnancies.
Combined trisomy 21 risk	1:90		The PAPP-A level is low.
