OBSTETRIC SONOGRAPHY – 2ND TRIMESTER ANOMALY (TIFFA) SCAN

Real time, B mode ultrasonography of the gravid uterus was performed.

Route : Transabdominal

Single live Intra uterine gestation.

MATERNAL : Cervix measures 3.6 cm in length.

Right Uterine Artery PI	0.58	Normal. No diastolic notch.
Left Uterine Artery	0.82	Normal. No diastolic notch.
Mean PI	0.69	Normal (18th centile)

As per fetal medicine, Barcelona.

FETUS :

Presentation - Changing lie, breech at present

Placenta - Anterior, no previa. No retro-placental clot.

Liquor - Adequate

Umbilical Cord - Three vessel cord seen with normal cord insertion.


Fetal Movements - Present

Cardiac activity - Present, Fetal Heart Rate - 148 bpm



IMPRESSION :

- Single, Live intra uterine gestation corresponding to gestational age of 18 weeks 6 days.
- Menstrual age is 19 weeks 3 days.
- No obvious structural congenital abnormality noted at this stage.
- assigned as per LMP.
- Liquor - Normal.
- Placenta - Anterior, no previa.
- Mean uterine artery PI values are within normal limits.

Advised follow up for interval growth, evolving anomalies and Fetal echocardiography at 24 weeks.
