Noncontrast & Contrast CT Whole Abdomen

Pre and postcontrast transaxial spiral scanning is done in the craniocaudal direction from the domes of the diaphragm to the lower border of the pelvic symphysis. Postcontrast scans are taken following intravenous injection of nonionic contrast agent, under strict aseptic conditions.

- Liver-is normal in size (142 mm), density and enhancement. No evidence of focal or diffuse parenchymal pathology. IIR are not dilated.
- Gall bladder-is normal in size, density and enhancement.(USG / MRCP are best modality for Cholelithiasis).
- CBD-is normal.
- Spleen is normal in size (85 mm), density and enhancement.
- Pancreas-is normal in size, density and enhancement. Pancreatic duct is not dilated.
- Bilateral Adrenals-appear normal.
- Both kidneys-are normal in size and enhancement. No evidence of any mass lesion. No evidence of calcification. Pelvicalyceal system appears minimally dilated on the left side. There is evidence of a renal calculus at the lower pole of left kidney, measuring 10 mm.
- Aorta & IVC-are normal in size and enhancement.
- Opacified bowel loops are normal.
- There is no evidence of ascites or loculated collection in the abdomen.
- Urinary bladder-is normal. Urinary bladder wall appears normal. No evidence of any calculus or mass.
- Prostate -is normal in size , density & enhancement .

IMPRESSION -

- Left renal calculus with minimal hydronephrosis. No ureteric calculus is seen.
