The calculated risk for Trisomy 13/18 test (with nuchal translucency) is below the cut off, which indicates a low risk.								
After the result of the Trisomy 21 test (with NT) it is expected that among 647 women with the same data, there is one woman with a trisomy 21 pregnancy and 646 women with not affected pregnancies.								
The PAPP-A level is low.
