Head

- Both Lateral Ventricle Appear Normal.
- The Cerebellum And Cisterna Megna Are Normal.

Spines

- Entire Spine Visualized In Longitudinal And Transverse Axis.
- Vertebrae And Spinal Canal Appear Normal.
- No Evidence Of Neural Tube Defect.

Neck

- No Cystic Lesion Seen Around The Neck.

Face

- Foetal Face Seen In The Coronal And Profile View.
- Both Orbita, Nose And Mouth Appear Normal.
- No Evidence Of Any Facial Cleft.

Thorax

- Normal Cardiac Situs.
- Four Chamber View Normal.
- Both Lungs Seen.  
(Foetal Echo Not Included)

Abdomen

- Abdominal Situs Is Normal Stomach Bubble Seen.
- Normal Bowel Pattern Appropriate For The Gestation Seen.
- No Evidence Of Ascites.
- Abdominal Wall Intact.
- Both Kidney And Bladder Appear Normal, Pelvicalyceal System Normal.

- All Foetal Bones Visualized And Appear Normal For The Period Of Gestation.
- Cord - Normal 2 Arteries And 1 Vein.

Bilateral Uterine Arteries.

- Bilateral Uterine Arteries Are Showing Normal Wave Form And Doppler Indices. Diastolic Notch Is Absent.
- Nasal Bone - 4.1 mm.
- Single Loop Of Cord Seen Near Neck.

Impression :- A single live intrauterine fetus of about 20 Weeks + 1 Days.
