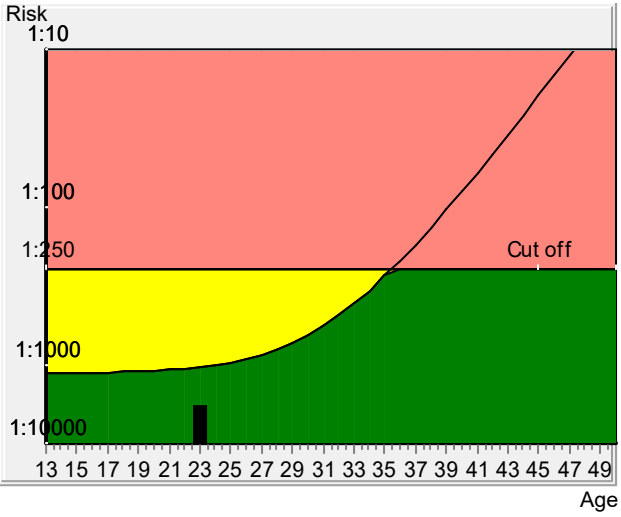

The PAPP-A level is low. The risk for this twin pregnancy has been calculated for a singleton pregnancy with corrected MoMs. The calculated risk by PRISCA depends on the accuracy of the information provided by the referring physician.
