Risk Cut off Age		The calculated risk for Trisomy 21 (with nuchal translucency) is above the cut off, which indicates an increased risk. After the result of the Trisomy 21 Test (with nuchal translucency), it is expected that among less than 50 pregnancies with the same data, there is one trisomy 21 pregnancy.
