REAL TIME ULTRASOUND OF ABDOMEN & PELVIS WAS PERFORMED

Liver is normal in size (~13.9 cm) and echotexture. No focal lesion seen. No intrahepatic biliary radical dilatation seen. Hepatic veins and IVC are patent.

Gall bladder shows normal wall thickness. Lumen is echofree.

CBD is not dilated measuring ~4 mm in diameter.

Portal vein is patent & shows hepatopetal flow.

Pancreas is normal in size & echo texture. Pancreatic duct not dilated. No peripancreatic fluid seen.

Spleen is normal in size measuring ~10.8 cm in bipolar length. No focal lesion seen.

Kidneys are normal in size. Bilateral cortical echogenicity normal with normal corticomedullary differentiation. Sinus echoes are normal. No hydronephrosis seen. Right kidney measures ~9.8 cm & left kidney measures ~10.6 cm in length. Parenchymal thickness of both kidneys are normal.

Ur. Bladder shows normal wall thickness. Lumen is echofree.

Prostate is normal in size measuring ~23 cc.

Aorta is normal. Retroperitoneal assessment suboptimal.

Miscellaneous- No significant adenopathy, collection or free fluid seen. No pleural effusion.

IMPRESSION-

- *Prominent non-compressible appendix (~9 mm) with significant surrounding mesenteric fat stranding, s/o acute appendicitis.*
