## XRAY RADIOGRAPH CHEST - PA

### OBSERVATIONS

Hazy opacity obscuring vessels with air bronchogram noted at right lower zone suggestive of consolidation.

Prominent bronchovascular markings noted in bilateral lung fields suggestive of pulmonary oedema.

Moderate left pleural effusion noted with blunting left CP angle.

Hilar Shadows are within normal limits.

Cardiac is normal in size.

Domes of Diaphragm are smooth on the right side.

Bones and soft tissue shadows appear normal.

### IMPRESSION

- Right lower zone consolidation with air bronchogram
- Bilateral pulmonary oedema
- Moderate left pleural effusion

### ADVICE

Clinical correlation recommended. Consider echocardiography to evaluate cardiac function given findings of pulmonary oedema and pleural effusion.
